

## KNOWLEDGE OF POLISH LANGUAGE – Level A1

**Level description:** Student can understand sentences and frequently used expressions related to the areas of most immediate relevance (e.g. very basic personal and family information, employment, daily routine). Can communicate simple and routine tasks requiring a simple and direct exchange of information on familiar and routine matters. Can describe in simple terms aspects of his/her background, immediate environment and matters in the areas of immediate need.

### Grammar:

- Student understands and uses basic grammar structures (noun genders, forms of adjectives, basic forms of verbs, verbs conjugation in the present tense)
- Student understands and is able to use the basic cases - accusative, instrumental, genitive
