1. Cześć! Dzień dobry! (Hi! Good afternoon!)

- a) greetings and goodbyes,

- d) age.

7. Lubię biegać (I like running)

- a) talking about hobbies,
- b) conjugation Types in Polish part II.

8. Moja rodzina (My family)

- a) family – vocabulary,
- b) accusative case.

9. Często czytam albo chodzę do kina (I often read or go to the cinema)
